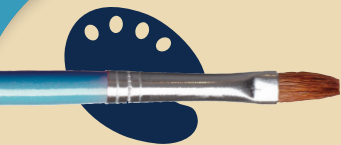
A name badge is needed for admission to lectures and exhibits. Spouses need to register for a badge for admission to lectures and /or exhibit hall.

Dr. Keith Levin was born on April 2, 1957 in Winnipeg, Canada. He graduated from Dentistry at the University of Manitoba in 1980. During his undergraduate education, Dr. Levin received the Proctor & Gamble scholarship and attended the University of North Carolina Research Conference, prompting an interest in original scientific research relating to dentistry. He maintained a full-time general dental practice in rural Manitoba for two years, then returned to Winnipeg for his orthodontic education. He completed his graduate orthodontic program at the University of Manitoba in 1985 with a certificate in orthodontics and a Masters in Science. His original research thesis studied the influence of ligation on friction, utilizing a 3 dimensional engineering analysis. Dr. Levin takes great interest in manufacturers claims relating to friction and bracket design!

Dr. Levin has maintained a full time private practice since 1985 with the Winnipeg Orthodontic Group. He has been fortunate to work with a number of fine orthodontists during that time and continues to practice with his wife, Dr. Babette Cohen and Dr. Susan Tsang.
